

Camp Crusader Summer Programs 2017

Academic Grades 3-8

Welcome to Camp Crusader Summer School academic grades 3-8. We are looking forward to having you on our campus. Classes start on Monday, June 19th and end Friday, July 14th. Please note we are closed on July 3rd and July 4th for the long weekend. If your child is part of the all day program (academic and camp combo) then on July 3rd they can attend camp all day starting at 8am (it is classes that will not be held).

On Monday, June 19th there will be a brief welcome and orientation at 7:30 AM in Lindland Theatre, located at the front entrance of the school. All students will be introduced to the summer school teachers and they will escort the children to their first class. Summer School assistants will be in the halls throughout the first week to ensure your child is able to find his/her classes. Parents are not required to be present for orientation but are welcomed to stay until your student is escorted to class.

Children who are dismissed at 10:50 AM can be picked up in the front of the school. If your child will be attending summer camp afterwards, then they will be escorted to camp by our staff immediately after his/her last class to join the camp.

Curb-Side Drop-Off Service in the mornings

Our trained staff will await the arrival of your child at our entrance and check them in. Starting on the first day of class you will see designated staff pointing you in the direction of curb side drop off.

Hours of drop-off are 7:45 a.m. to 8:15 a.m. (first day of class drop-off is from 7:10am - 7:30am as we have orientation at 7:30am on this day)

After Care:

Students enrolled in the after care program will be escorted to the after care center by our staff. After-care headquarters will be located in the cafeteria.

While summer school dress is casual, students are expected to be clean and neat in their attire. We encourage the students that are also attending the sports camp dress appropriately for sports activities. Clothing with any form of offensive images or text are not allowed. We ask that hats not be worn inside the school building.

Camp Lunch:

If your child is transferring into the sports camp in the afternoon then lunch and an afternoon snack will be provided. If your child has severe food allergies we recommend you pack your child a lunch and snack daily. We recommend campers bring water bottles and they are allowed to bring extra snacks if they please.
