In order to maximize the fun and safety here at Camp Crusader, we would like to make sure that all campers and parents are well-informed of camp procedures, upcoming events, a list of items each camper should remember to bring to camp each day and required forms to turn into camp. We anticipate a summer full of fun and games! Our camp counselors will be available Monday morning to answer questions and make any adjustments you may have.

Please Note: If you enrolled in Minecraft, 3D Printing & Design, Filmmaking, Photography, Cooking, Automotive or Band camp you will be directly receiving a welcome email, this document is for Crusader Day Camp only.

This season our basketball courts will be set up outdoors as we are excited to announce the renovations of our new state of the art gym facilities to be completed this Summer, indoor basketball camp activities will return in Summer of 2018 for our campers to enjoy brand new facilities.

Items to bring:

- ☀ Sweater (San Francisco can be chilly in the Summer)
- ☀ Camper t-shirt (handed out the first day of camp) and a regular t-shirt.
- ☀ Tennis Shoes
- ☀ Hat or Visor
- ☀ Extra snacks
- ☀ A water bottle
- ☀ A baseball glove if you have one.

- ☀ If your child would like a locker to store personal items, please have him/her bring a lock. It is recommended that you provide our staff with the combination or a spare key in the event the combination is forgotten or key is lost, to prevent the staff from having to cut the lock.
- ☀ For Summer School please bring your back pack with all pertinent school items.
- ☀ Make sure all items are labeled!
- ☀ LOTS OF ENERGY AND A BIG SMILE!

*Note: Please remember to have your child eat a healthy breakfast before camp, lunch, beverages and snacks are provided at camp.

Parent's Notification **What Not to Bring to Camp**

Camp Crusader asks that the following items please not be brought to camp by campers:

- Gaming systems
- Pets
- Over-The-Counter Medications
- Candy
- Cash
- Toys
- Alcohol
- Drugs
- Weapons
- Expensive Items

Camp Crusader will not be responsible for loss or damage to personal property.

Pre-Care

Pre-care opens at 8am sharp and you can drop your child off inside the cafeteria for check-in. Please do not drop your child off any earlier than 8am, we will not have staff present at this time. Please do not drop your child off in the lobby of the school, it is not part of the camp.

After-Care

Please let us know each morning if your camper will be attending after-care. Please ensure your camper is picked up at after-care by 6pm sharp everyday. Your Bunk 1 account will be charged \$50 for every 15 minutes you are late in picking up your camper. Please pick up your camper in the back lot area of the school, you will see a camp counselor.

Camper Illness or Injury

The following procedures will take place in case your camper becomes ill or is injured while at camp.

Illness:

1. Any health care treatment or first aid will immediately be given.
2. Camper will be taken to our First Aid facility to rest.
3. Camp Doctor will be notified if necessary.
4. Parents will be notified.
5. Camper Illness or Injury report will be taken and a copy provided to parents.

Serious Injury:

1. Any health care or first aid/CPR will immediately be given.
2. 911 will be notified if necessary, if not camper will be taken to First Aid facility.
3. Parents will be notified.
4. Camp Doctor will be notified.
5. Camper Illness or Injury report will be taken and a copy provided to parents.

Camp Entrance

The Camp Crusader entrance for picking up your camper after camp is located at 175 Phelan Ave in the back of the school, you can't miss it you will see a line of cars entering the camp. You may pull into the camp entrance parking lot, park and pick your child up from camp or we will escort your child up to your vehicle for sign-out as you pull up to the camp. Only authorized individuals, identified in writing on the camper release form, will be allowed to access the camp to take campers home.

Please utilize our curbside drop-off service in the mornings or if you need to enter the school use curbsides in the front of the school or across the street to park and then enter the camp through the front of the school.

Curb-Side Drop-Off Service

Our trained staff will await the arrival of your child at our camp entrance and check them in. On the first day of camp you will see designated staff pointing you in the direction of camp curbside drop off.

Hours of drop-off are

7:55 a.m. to 8:15 a.m.

8:55 a.m. to 9:15 a.m.

Missing a day of camp or arriving late

All day-campers will be receiving a camp t-shirt.
