HS Summer School - If you are enrolled in ONE CLASS

Welcome to HS Summer School,

Summer school begins on Tuesday, June 13th and ends Thursday July 20th . Students must be in Lindland Theatre by 7:30 AM for orientation with Mr. Zumbado, if their class is scheduled at 8:00 AM (session 1).

If the class is scheduled at 10:00 AM (session 2), we ask that the student check-in, in Room 105, by 9:30 AM for their orientation.

If the class is scheduled at 12:00 PM (session 3), we ask that the student check-in, in Room 105, by 11:30 AM for their orientation.

You will receive an email in regards to your class schedule and start time.

Please note that all rules and expectations provided during orientation must be followed.

DRESS CODE

Students are expected to wear khaki colored, Docker-type pants and a plain, solid color polo shirt (i.e. no images or designs on the shirt) to school. Pants must be clean, in good repair, not excessively baggy or tight and must be worn at the waist (sagging pants is not allowed). Shirts must also fit appropriately. Solid color sweatshirts and jackets are allowed, providing they are clean, in good repair, not excessively large and free of any graphics. Hats may not be worn in the building. Students who are deemed by the staff or administration to be dressed inappropriately will be sent home to change and the class missed will count as an absence. If a student comes to school dressed inappropriately again, s/he will be asked to leave the summer program. Tattoos and body piercings are not to be visible while at school. Hairstyles must be neat and school appropriate. Shaved lines or designs are not allowed. Extreme hair color or styles are not allowed. The Summer School Director is the final judge of what is appropriate.

ATTENDANCE

Due to the nature of summer school and the hours required for credit, it is critical that

students are present and on time to classes.

Students who miss more than ten minutes of class will be marked absent for the class. Three tardies of more than ten minutes will count as one class absence. Students are only allowed two absences. A student who misses more than two class periods will be asked to leave. No credit will be given for the course, and no refund will be give; no exceptions.

If a student will be absent or late, please call [415\) 586-8200, extension 394](tel:4155868200) and leave a message. When students arrive late, they should report directly to Room 112 to receive a tardy pass.

SMOKING/DRINKING/ILLEGAL CONTRABAND

ARHS is a non-smoking campus. Any student found smoking on or near campus may be asked to leave the summer program. Any student found to be under the influence of, in possession of, or distributing any drug or alcohol will be dismissed from the summer program and the police be called.

PARKING & DROP-OFF/PICK-UP

There is no parking available on our campus for students. Students must park on the streets or in City College's parking lot (a daily fee is required). Students should be dropped off and picked up in front of school, not in the back parking lot due to Camp Crusader. Rides should be considerate of the traffic on Phelan Avenue, especially of the busses, and cooperate with any and all ARHS staff members making requests with regard to stopping in front of the school.
