Greetings Parent(s) and Guardian(s):

This is to confirm that your son has been registered in our Summer Freshmen Academic Introduction Program. The week before the program begins you will be notified via email on the classroom time and location for the Algebra and English course. One course will begin at 8:15am and end at 9:45am and the second course will begin at 10am and end at 11:30am.

On our first day, Monday June 17th we ask that your son arrive at 8:00 AM for orientation and report to the **school cafeteria**, Chaminade Hall. At this time there will be a welcome and introduction of the summer staff and his teachers.

For the English portion of our program please ensure your son brings a copy of Night by Elie Wiesel, his iPad, a notebook, binder, two folders and a pen and pencil.

DRESS CODE

Students are expected to wear khaki colored, Docker-type pants or shorts and a solid black or white color polo shirt (i.e. no images or designs on the shirt) to school. Pants must be clean, in good repair, not excessively baggy or tight and must be worn at the waist (sagging pants is not allowed). Shirts must also fit appropriately. Only ARHS or solid colored sweatshirts and jackets are allowed, providing they are clean, in good repair, and not excessively large. Hats may not be worn in the building. Students who are deemed by the staff or administration to be dressed inappropriately will be sent home to change, and the class missed will count as an absence. If a student comes to school dressed inappropriately again, he will be asked to leave the summer program. Tattoos and body piercings are not to be visible while at school. Hairstyles must be neat and school appropriate. Shaved lines or designs are not allowed. Extreme hair color or styles are not allowed. The Summer School Dean, Mr. Juan Zumbado, is the final judge of what is appropriate.

SMOKING/DRINKING/ILLEGAL CONTRABAND

ARHS is a non-smoking campus. Any student found smoking on or near campus may be asked to leave the summer program. Any student found to be under the influence of, in possession of, or distributing any drug or alcohol will be dismissed from the summer program, and the police will be called.
